BY-LAW NUMBER 2017-196

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 2006-55 BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE SIGNS AND OTHER ADVERTISING DEVICES IN THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE

WHEREAS Section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25 as amended, authorizes a Municipality to pass by-laws respecting signs;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Belleville deems it advisable to amend Bylaw Number 2006-55, the Sign By-law;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT Section 4.2(1)(c) of By-law Number 2006-55 is hereby amended by the removal of the word "and" at the end of clause (iv);
- 2. THAT Section 4.2(1)(c) of By-law Number 2006-55 is hereby amended by the deletion of clauses (v) and (vi);
- 3. That Section 4.2(1)(c) of By-law Number 2006-55 is hereby amended by the addition of the following clauses immediately following clause (iv):
 - (v) Signs must be a minimum of 195 feet (60m) from the middle of any intersection:
 - (vi) Signs shall not be permitted in any centre median;
 - (vii) Signs shall not be permitted between the sidewalk and the curb;
 - (viii) Signs shall be setback a minimum of 15 feet (4.57m) from the edge of a driveway and any curb line or edge of the travelled portion of a street;
 - (ix) Signs shall be setback a minimum of 1 foot (0.3m) from a sidewalk;
 - (x) Signs advertising the same candidate shall be a minimum of 33 feet (10m) apart; and
 - (xi) where located on a street that is not under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the City of Belleville, that authorization has been obtained from the necessary authorities.

THIS BY-LAW SHALL COME INTO FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY ON AND AFTER THE PASSING THEREOF.
